-Scholarship Opportunity:

This scholarship award will be a one-time \$500.00 and may go towards costs of furthering education at a college, university, or trade school.

-About the scholarship honoree:

-Lion Robert Frye (1925-2018) was a lifelong resident of Long View, North Carolina and actively involved in his community.

- He was awarded North Carolina's highest civilian honor, the Order of the Long Leaf Pine by Governor James B. Hunt Jr. for his community service. He also received numerous awards and recognition for his service in the US Air Force and the US Navy.

- He worked in construction as a general contractor and was a member of the Hickory Regional Planning Commission. He was instrumental in the building of the Long View Recreation Center and helped to build the first building on the campus of Camp Dogwood for Blind and Visually Impaired that is owned and operated by the North Carolina Lions Foundation located in Catawba County on Lake Norman.

-As a Lion, Robert was active in the Long View Lions Club for 61 years. He served in various leadership roles at the local, district, and state levels.

-About Lions International:

We are the world's largest community service organization with 1.4 million members serving local and global communities in more than 200 countries. In 1925 Helen Keller challenged the Lions to be the "Knights of the Blind in the Crusade against Darkness" and we accepted the challenge. Lions International's motto is "We Serve" and our focus areas are childhood cancer, diabetes awareness, disaster relief, environment, humanitarianism, hunger, vision, and youth.
